

COVID-19 Advisory Group
UU Church of Waterville - Pandemic Protocols
as of June 1, 2022

- **Sunday Services are Multi-platform** (In-person and Zoom) with **no Coffee Hour** in Averill Parlors, for now
- **Small Groups may meet** in the church

...assuming these **In-Church Protocols** are followed:

- **Wear a mask** (multi-layer, well-fitted, preferably N95 or KN95) that covers nose and mouth
- **Maintain a distance** (ideally 3 feet) from people not in your “bubble”
- **Practice good hygiene** (handwashing and/or sanitizing)
- **Sing** (if you choose) **with mask still on**
- **Limited (not shared) eating and drinking is allowed.** Put your mask back on as soon as possible.
- Understand that you are in the church **at your own risk**
- If you **test positive, cease attending and isolate for 5-10 days** (consult your doctor)
- **Air quality/ventilation:** Where possible, use the air filtrations systems. As weather permits, open doors and windows and use fans, or move meetings outside.

These Protocols may change, depending on risk levels in the county and state.
